



Planting Instructions

1. Place approximately 40mm of coarse material (straw, garden waste, gravel etc) in the base of the Garden.

2. Place a central watering "core" down the centre of

the Garden. A rolled up sack or newspaper is ideal. The core should be long enough to reach from the top of the Garden and sit on the base material, with a diameter of at least 40mm.

- 3. Build up the Garden with good quality potting mix or compost to the first holes patting down very firmly.
- 4. Lay the roots of your plant through the hole onto the soil. Cover the roots and hold in firmly with soil.
- 5. Fill the planter to the next holes and repeat, building up your Garden to the top.
- 6. Use the central "core" to ensure all plants receive adequate water
